Upon review of final course grades for the year, your son/daughter has received a failing grade in one or more academic course(s).

1. Please log on to either Parent Portal or Student Portal to view the final report card.
Both Parent Portal and Student Portal links can be found at <https://nbthsguidance.com/>
All students have access to Student Portal. The username is his/her id number@nbtsschools.org, the password is the same one that your son/daughter uses to access school computers.
2. Click on the "letters" tab to view the course(s) that your son/daughter failed. These courses can be remediated over the summer using the options listed below. Please read the information below when considering the proper course(s) to enroll in.

Your son/daughter has the option to enroll in a summer school program to regain credits to fulfill the NJ State Graduation Requirements. Below are the summer school options. Follow the necessary steps:

A. If your son/daughter received an Academic Failure "F" in a course

1. See summer school list for courses that are available (attached).
2. Register for the 60 credit hour "Credit Recovery" course.
3. When signing up for online courses through NJ Virtual School (NJVS.ORG) students will be auto-approved for courses they select through NJVS. All issues must be addressed directly with NJ Virtual School.
4. NBTHS staff will not be able to audit course registrations for any summer school programs. The student and parent/guardian is responsible for summer registrations. Credits cannot be awarded for completing the wrong course.

B. If your son/daughter received an "FA" (failure due to attendance):

1. See Pages 20-21 in the student handbook for attendance policy and loss of credit information.
2. Contact the Assistant Principal for your son/daughter's grade to confirm the loss of credits.
3. Register for the 120 credit hour "Comprehensive" course.
4. Department supervisors must give approval for any comprehensive courses.
5. When signing up for online courses through NJ Virtual School (NJVS) students will be auto-approved for courses they select through NJVS. All issues must be addressed directly with NJ Virtual School.
6. The student and parent/guardian is responsible for summer registration. Credits cannot be awarded for completing the wrong course. NBTHS staff will not be able to audit course registrations for any summer school programs.

Any failed course(s) will be repeated the following year unless remediated in summer school. The class(es) will remain in your son/daughters schedule until the passing summer school grade is received on an official transcript from the summer school program (and the correct course and credits are verified). Courses must be completed by any deadlines imposed by the summer schools or NJVS. **No course completion extensions can be granted for any reason.**

Below is information on the summer school programs approved by the North Brunswick Township Board of Education and NJDOE for your review. Please note that each summer school program may have different deadlines and fees associated with the course(s). I strongly encourage your son/daughter to enroll in a summer school program to ensure that your child's ability to participate in athletics/extracurricular activities next year and graduate on time with his or her class will not be impacted.

\$650.00 for a full-year comprehensive course (120 hours)
