

College Level Courses Available at NBTHS

There are 3 sets of courses that earn college credits at NBTHS:

1. **Advanced Placement Courses-** Students must take the AP Test for each course in May and score a 4 or 5 to be eligible for college credit. The awarding of college credit for these courses is at the discretion of each individual college a student will attend and is subject to that college's policies.

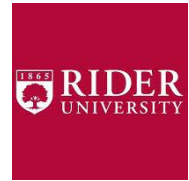
